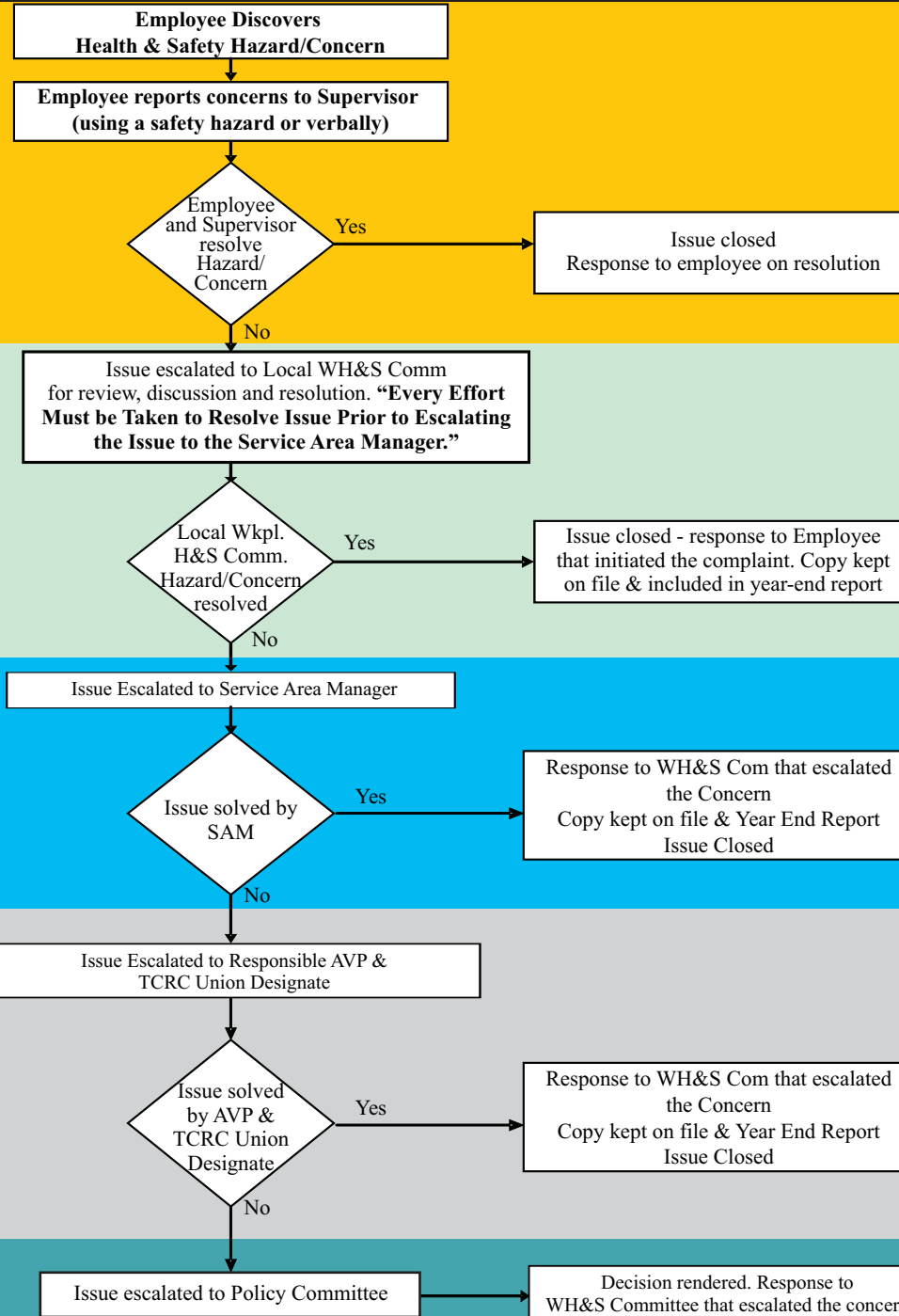


Transportation/Field Operations Health & Safety Committee HAZARD/CONCERN ESCALATION PROCESS



Local reporting processes will define time periods for reporting, responses, and/or movement to a local workplace committee for recommendation.

30 DAYS

30 days from the time the committee determines that the issue cannot be resolved, the issue should be escalated to the SAM.

Escalation to each level must be done in writing and include a risk-assessment when proposing changes to current operating practices/rules.

WHSC is responsible to raise the issue to the next level in the escalation process until resolution.

Escalation to the policy committee must be addressed to the co-chairs and/or secretary in writing.

30 DAYS

SAM has 30 days to resolve issue locally. If issue cannot be resolved, it should be escalated to the Responsible AVP/TCRC Union Designate.

Responsible AVP/TCRC Union designate attempt to resolve issue if issue cannot be resolved, it should be escalated to the Policy Committee.
